Dear Mr. Michael Annett,  
 I am writing to you to urge you and the State President to help finalise the ANZMI website issue which is still outstanding.  
 I have promised the National Tribunal Panel that I will not cause the RSL name any harm in any way. You have promised me that you will instruct the persons responsible to remove the material concerning me, an RSL member, off that illegal website. I would like to know from you if you intend to do so or not.  
 My supporters and myself have stayed away from the Sub-Branch and its issues. In time, it will be proven to you and the State President that certain members, who in our opinion caused the upheaval and are still on the committee, are the wrong choice to represent you in Healesville.

You must be aware of the National Tribunal decision which took about eight weeks to reach. In the meantime, I accept your wish to keep me and my previous committee off the Sub-Branch committees, but I will not accept to be discredited on an illegal website like ANZMI, neither should both of you. Although we had our differences, we all worked to the best of our abilities for the RSL.

Please advise me if the State President and yourself are going to take action to remove the abovementioned ANZMI material.

It is sad to hear from a committee member that only about two dozen members (half of them on the committee and their wives), attended the Sub-Branch General Meeting that took place last Sunday. During my time, we used to have between 120 and 150 members attending. We do not want to see any more damage to Healesville RSL Sub-Branch. We want to move on and help RSL members, the senior members in particular.

We are still interested in meeting with the State President and yourself, bearing in mind that I accept his wish not to have me on the committees for a certain period. Unless the State President drops the remaining charge and asks me to return and unite the two existing factions, I am not interested in going on any RSL committees, nor do my RSL member supporters.

Mr. Annett, I do sincerely write this e-mail to both of you, hoping for a favourable reply, soon.
