Dear Mike, John and Members Healesville Sub-Branch

Further to discussions with the CEO RSL State Branch this afternoon I tender my resignation as Healesville Sub-Branch V.P League (acting president) and as a member of the general committee.

I thank those at the Sub-Branch, Anzac House and in particular Mr. John Wells for the trust, faith and respect for me during these troubled times.

It is my view the Sub-Branch is on the brink of collapse. I have done my best to lead from the middle of the road drawing on the strengths from all protagonists. It has been inadequate. Those who claim so loudly, and frequently, that whatever they do is "For the RSL", hollow words from hollow hearts and souls.

Everyone should be disturbed, outraged and alarmed at the manner some members have directed a campaign to discredit and dishonour individual members and subsequently Healesville Sub-Branch. The open distention, dissatisfaction and hostility between members is beyond comprehension. I am outraged at this behaviour from mature individuals of such a responsible organisation that should have significant standing within the Healesville community. Our local reputation now tattered and in ruins.
